Materials

If you don't like to sew, you can use craft glue instead!

Felt Sheets

(1 each of 5 colors, plus one thicker black sheet)

Orange

Yellow

White

Black

Red

Straight Pins



Needle & Embroidery Thread (in all 5 colors)

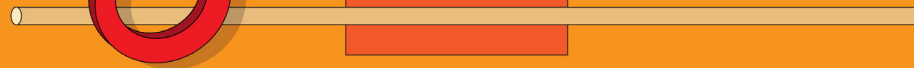


Scissors



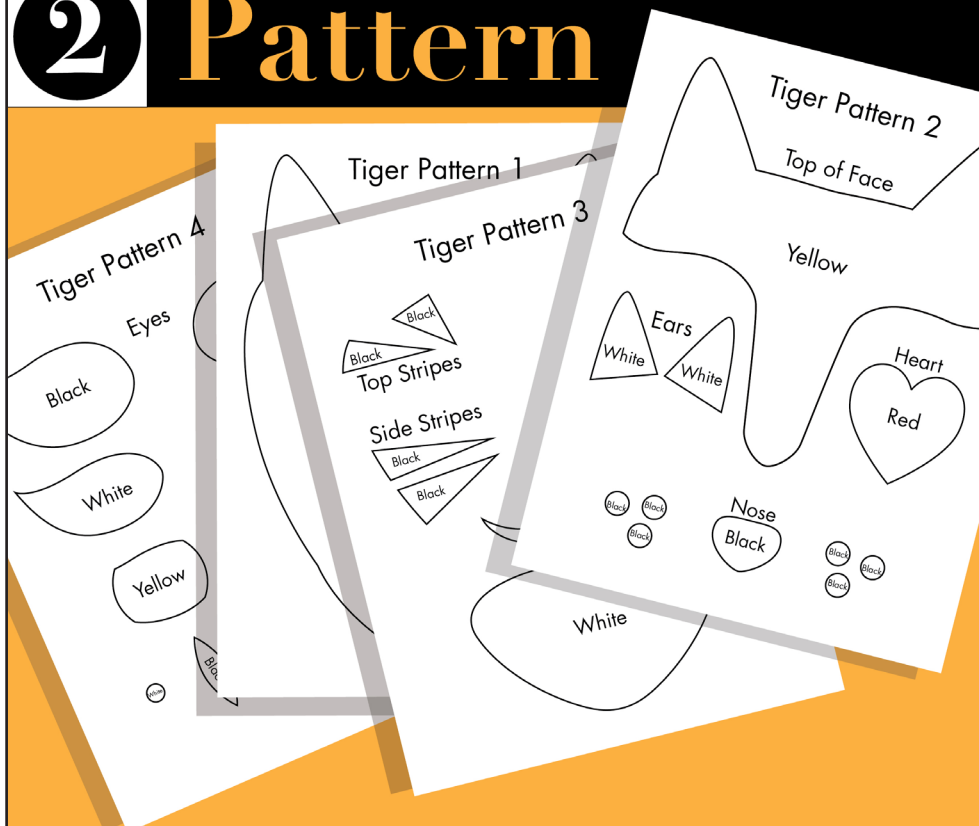
12" length of Twine

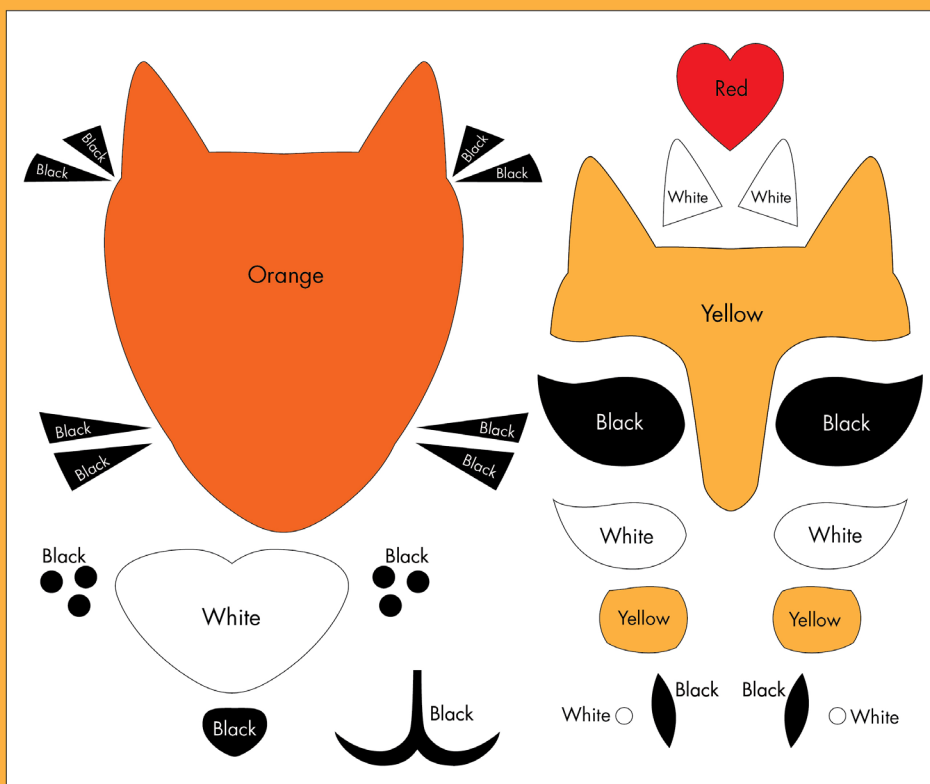
Pattern

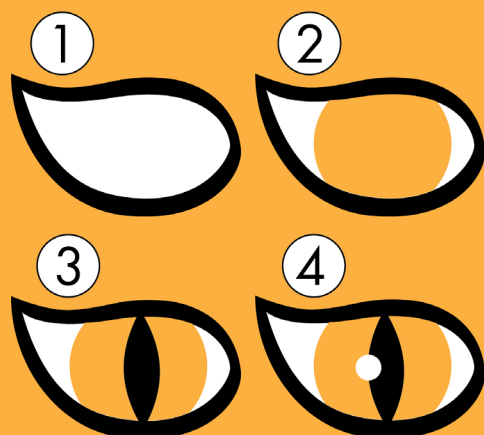
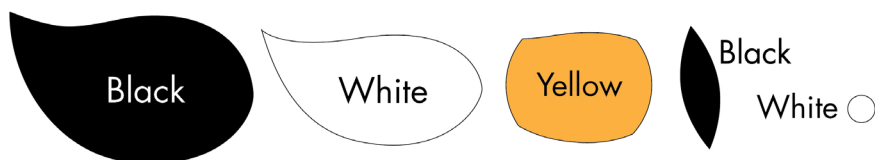
Use the pattern sheets to cut out the felt pieces. It may be helpful to pin the patterns to the felt with straight pins, then cut around the outlines.



Start to sew!

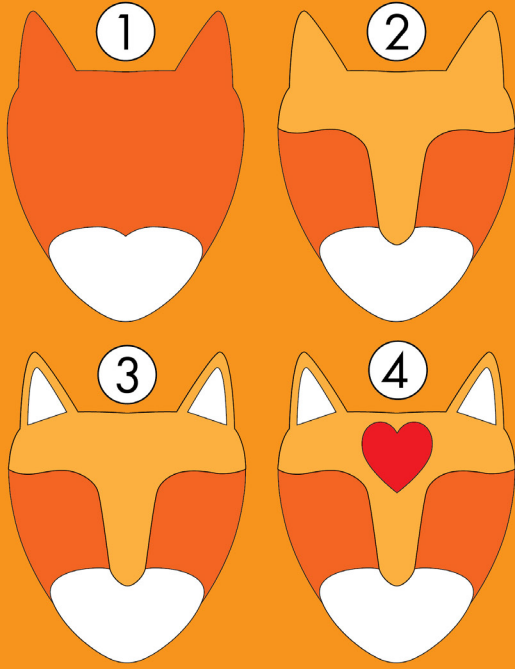
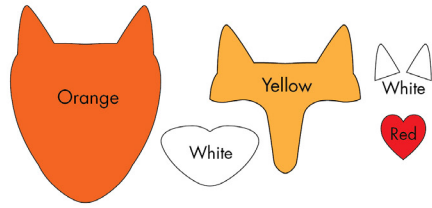

Sew the EYES! Use small, close stitches around the edges of the shapes. Use thread to match the color of the shape you are sewing down.

Sew the Face!

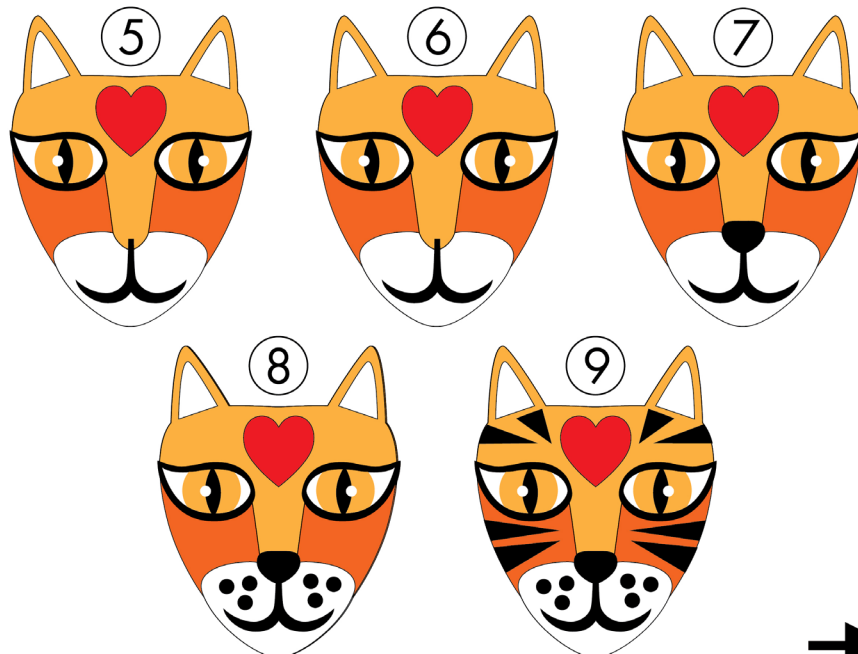
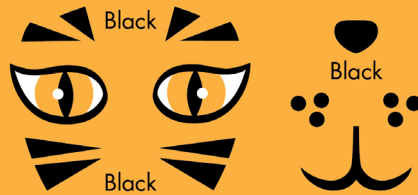


As you stack the shapes, sew each one all the way through the bottom layers. It will make a quilted look. You may want to use straight pins to position the pieces as you go.

Prepare the Banner

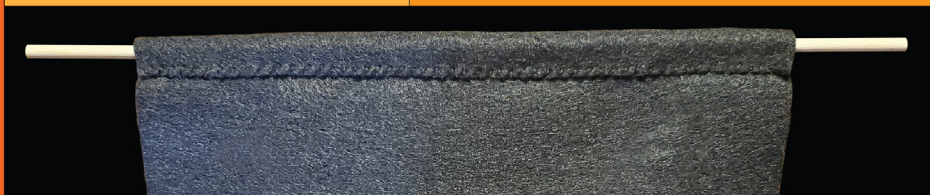
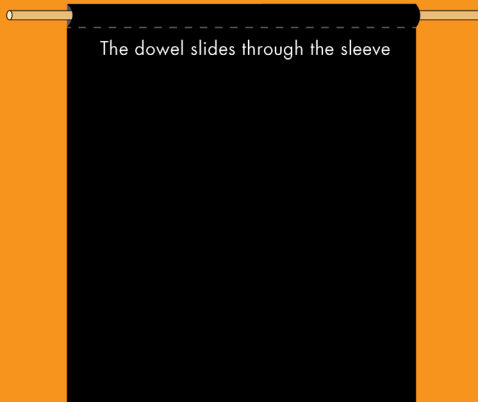
The thick black felt sheet will be the banner surface. Fold over the top about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch to make a sleeve for the dowel to slide through. Sew along the bottom edge of the fold (using black thread). This will be the back side of the banner.

Fold over the top about $\frac{1}{2}$ inch

Sew along the edge to make a sleeve



The dowel slides through the sleeve

Sew on the Tiger!

Center the tiger face on the black banner surface and sew all around the edge.
