

Make

Felt PATCHES

**or
PINS!**



Materials

This is a sewing project but can also be done with glue, for those who don't like to sew. You will be making 3 decorative patches (that you can choose to turn into pins by adding pin backs).



Thick Felt in white, yellow, blue



Needle & Thread

(thread colors: yellow, white, red, blue, black)



Thinner Felt in black, blue, red, white



SCISSORS

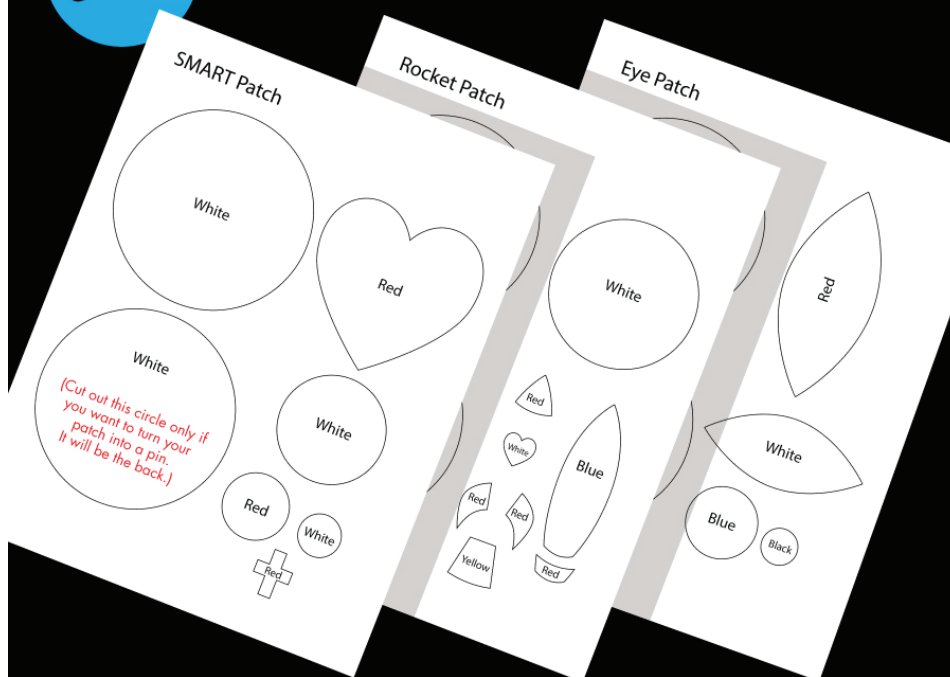


Pin Backs

STEP 1

Print out PATTERNS

STEP 2

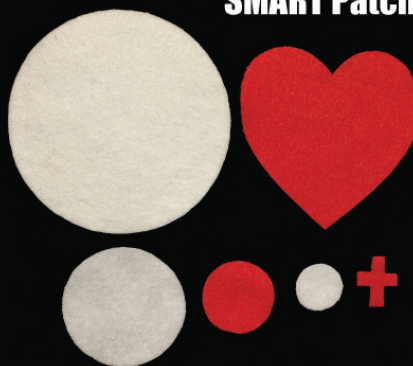
Cut out the patch pieces.

Use the patterns to cut out the patch pieces. Keep the pieces organized between the 3 different patches so they don't get mixed up.

NOTE: Be sure to use the thicker felt for the large circle.

ALSO: Each of the patterns includes 2 large circular pieces. The 2nd circles aren't shown here. They will be used only if you opt to make a pin instead of a patch.

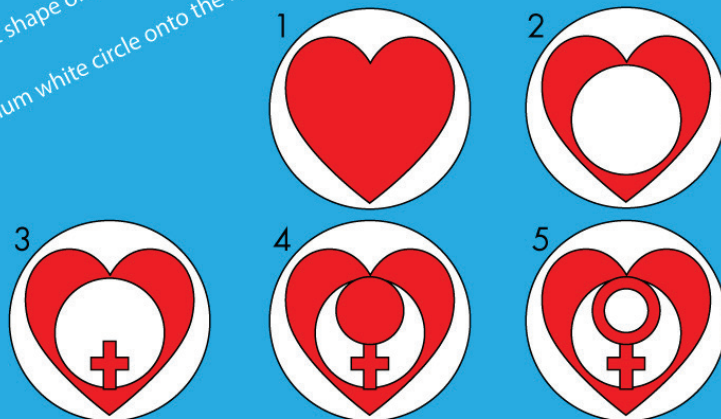
STEP 3

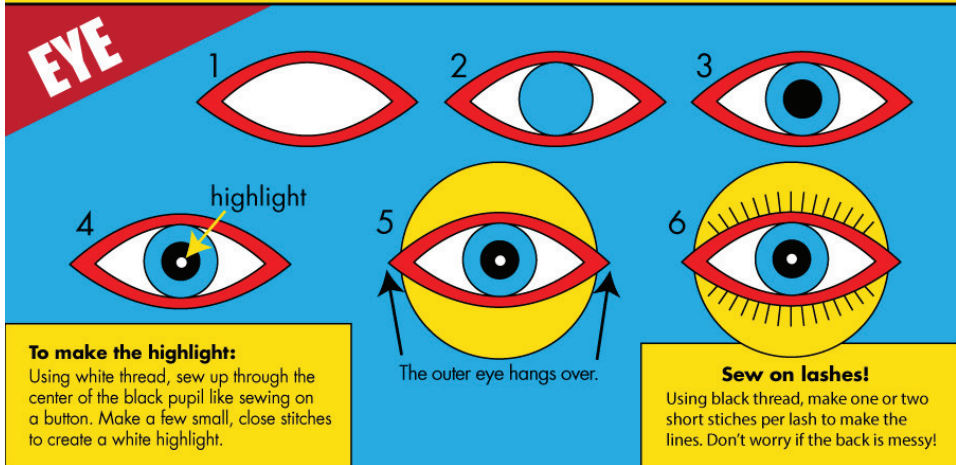
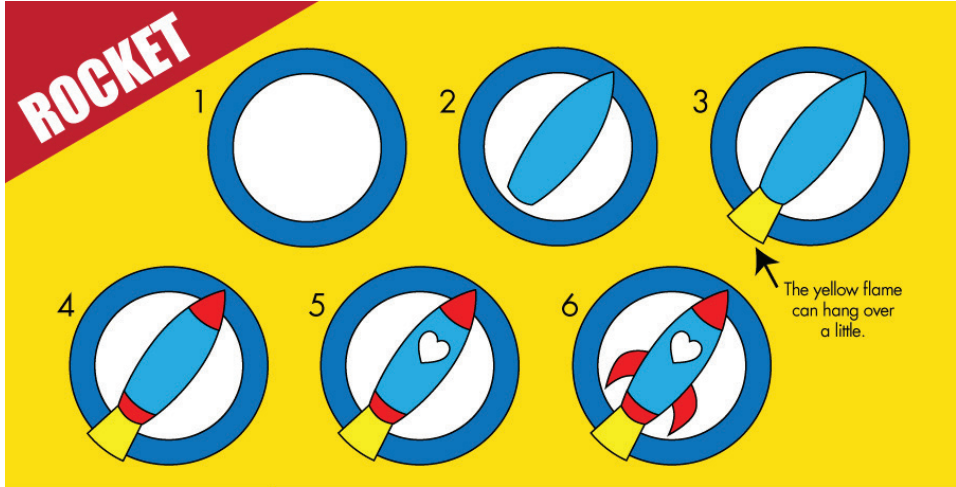
Sew the patches!

For each patch, sew (or glue) the felt pieces onto the thicker felt circle. You may find it helpful to use straight pins to hold the pieces in place while you sew. You will be sewing on the pieces in ordered layers from the bottom up, as shown below. As you stack the pieces, you will be sewing up through all the previous layers to create a quilted look.

HEART

1. Sew the heart shape onto the thick white circle.
2. Sew the medium white circle onto the heart shape.
3. etc.





STEP 4

To make a patch into a pin:

Cut out the 2nd large circle from the thicker felt. This will be the reverse side of the pin.

1. Sew the pin back onto the felt circle as shown.
2. Glue this circle to the back of the patch.
3. Sew around the edge to complete the pin.
