



## FOX MASK


INSTRUCTIONS





Use the pattern sheets to cut out the felt pieces.

To cut out all the eyes, slightly fold the felt and make a snip inside the eye area to start the cut.






Sew the grey face pieces to the black face shape. Use the grey thread. It will be helpful to pin the pieces to the black background to keep them in place as you sew.

Leave the designated areas\* loose. They will be sewn down when the front face is attached to the white backing.









Sew on the red heart, red dot, and red ear pieces. Use the red thread. Be sure the heart is positioned at the right height to allow room for the blue flourishes.





Sew on the blue flourishes and the blue eye shapes. Use the blue thread. For the eye shapes, sew down just the inside edges. Leave the outer edges loose.








Sew on the white dots with white thread. Sew on the nose with black thread.

Step four

Sew the dowel sleeve to the white backing.

This will be the reverse side of the mask.



Sew down the top edge and two side edges of the sleeve. Leave the bottom edge open to slip in the dowel.

## Step five

Attach the mask backing.

Align the white backing to the back of the black mask.

Use black thread to sew all around the edge, including the inner edges of the eyes.







## Add the dowel and you're done!
