

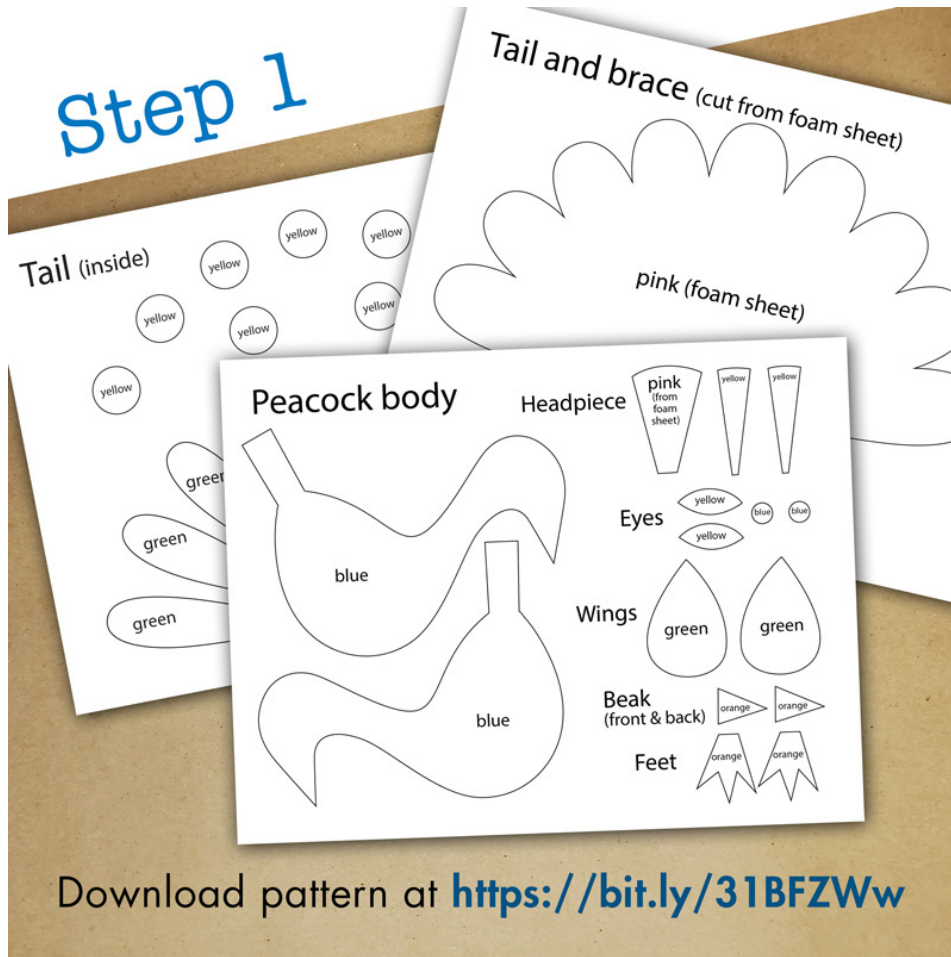
Make a PEACOCK



Materials



Step 1



Download pattern at <https://bit.ly/31BFZWw>

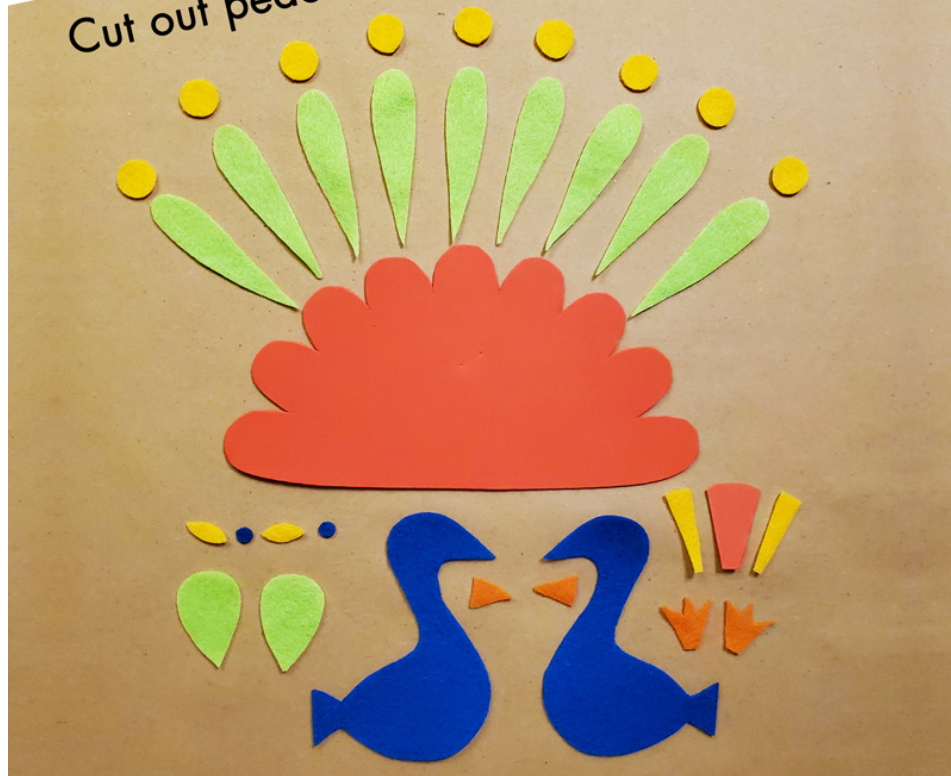
Step 2

Cut out pattern pieces and attach to corresponding felt/foam sheets. The larger pieces can be pinned down (but don't pin to foam sheet—it makes a dent!)



Step 3

Cut out peacock parts.



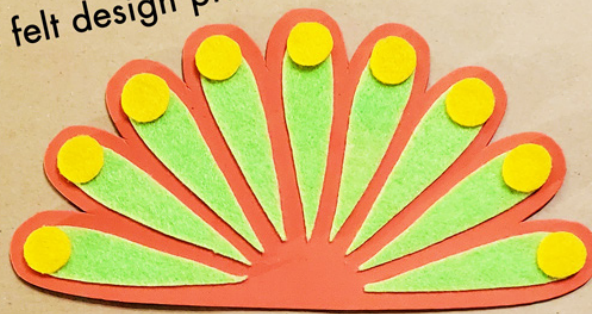
Step 4

Glue the felt design pieces to the foam tail.

Glue the stripes to the headpiece, one on each side.

Glue the eyes and wings on the peacock body. Make sure that the body pieces face each other!

Let everything dry!!!
(at least an hour)



Step 5

Sew the 2 peacock body sides together. Tuck in the head piece and feet and sew in place.

Tuck in headpiece and sew in place.



Leave a gap for putting in the stuffing.

IMPORTANT!

Don't sew these two pieces (1 & 2) together!

Sew down along this line and keep the 2 tab pieces loose.

They are for gluing to the tail.

Tuck in feet and sew in place.

Step 6

Poke in the stuffing. You can use a pencil to push it in, especially in the neck. Don't worry if you can't fill up the head area. It can be flat.

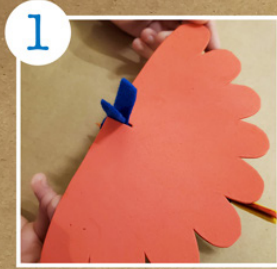
After you've finished stuffing the body, sew the opening closed.



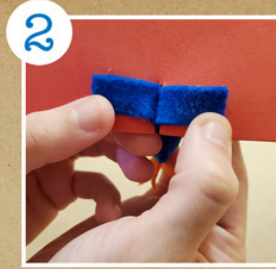
Glue on the beak, front and back.

Step 7

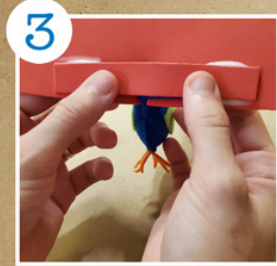
Attach the tail!



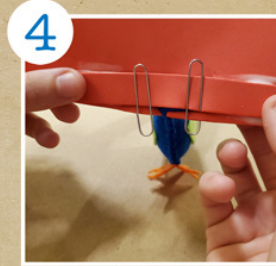
Slide the two tab pieces through the slot in the tail.



Fold the blue tabs down and glue to the tail surface.



Glue the wing brace over the blue tabs.



Secure the wing brace with paper clips and let dry.

Step 8

After letting dry for several hours, remove the paperclips!
