



If you don't like to sew, you can use craft glue or a glue













(Use straight pins to secure the larger pieces in place before sewing.)

Position the wings as shown, with the smaller wings on top of the larger ones. Pin in place. You will be sewing 3 short black lines out from the center of each set of wings to tack them down. The ends of the wings will remain loose.




Sew 3 short lines out from the center of the wings. Leave the edges loose.







Position the yellow wing shape on the orange background as shown. Pin in place and sew down using yellow thread.



Sew on the blue and pink wing decorations using blue and pink thread, respectively. You will be sewing through both the yellow and orange wing layers to make a quilted look.









Sew on the body with black thread. To make the antennas, use black thread and sew 2 lines branching out from the top of the head.

Use short, close stitches to sew the antennas.



Sew on the pink and yellow circles using pink and yellow thread, respectively.







Align the bee and butterfly pieces to the front of their respective back pieces and sew around the edges with orange thread.
