



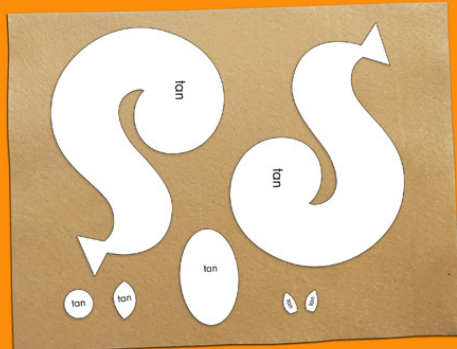
# Step One



Download pattern at <https://bit.ly/3nNR2Fd>

# Step Two

Cut out the pattern parts and attach them to the corresponding color felt sheets. You will be cutting around them.



You can pin down the larger paper pieces, but the smaller ones you will need to hold in place to cut around.

## Step Three

Cut out all the pieces!



## Step Four

Glue (or sew) the yellow stripes to the tail pieces. Be sure the pieces are facing opposite directions. Then glue the 2 sides together back to back. Let dry!



## Step Five

1

Cut a slot on the back half of the squirrel body.



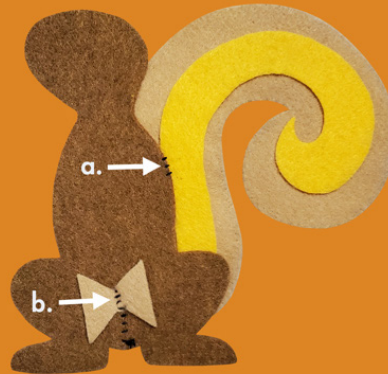

Slide the tail ends into the slot like this.



## Attach the tail.

- a. Tack on the tail to the body here.
- b. Sew the slot together over the tail ends.

Now work on the front half. →

## Step Six

Glue (or sew) on the eye and nose pieces to the squirrel's face.

Glue (or sew) on the chest and heart.

Glue on the insides of the ears.



## Step Seven



1

Tuck the ears under the head and pin down as shown. Pin the arms to the body.

2 Layer the front and back body pieces and prepare to sew them together. The ears will be sewn down between the two body pieces. The arms will be sewn on top of the front piece in the position shown—(you will be attaching the shoulders and letting the forearms hang loose).



## Step Eight



Start sewing at the arrow and proceed around. As you sew, you can also add stuffing as sections become enclosed. Use a pencil to poke the stuffing into the extremities. Finish sewing the edge. . .
