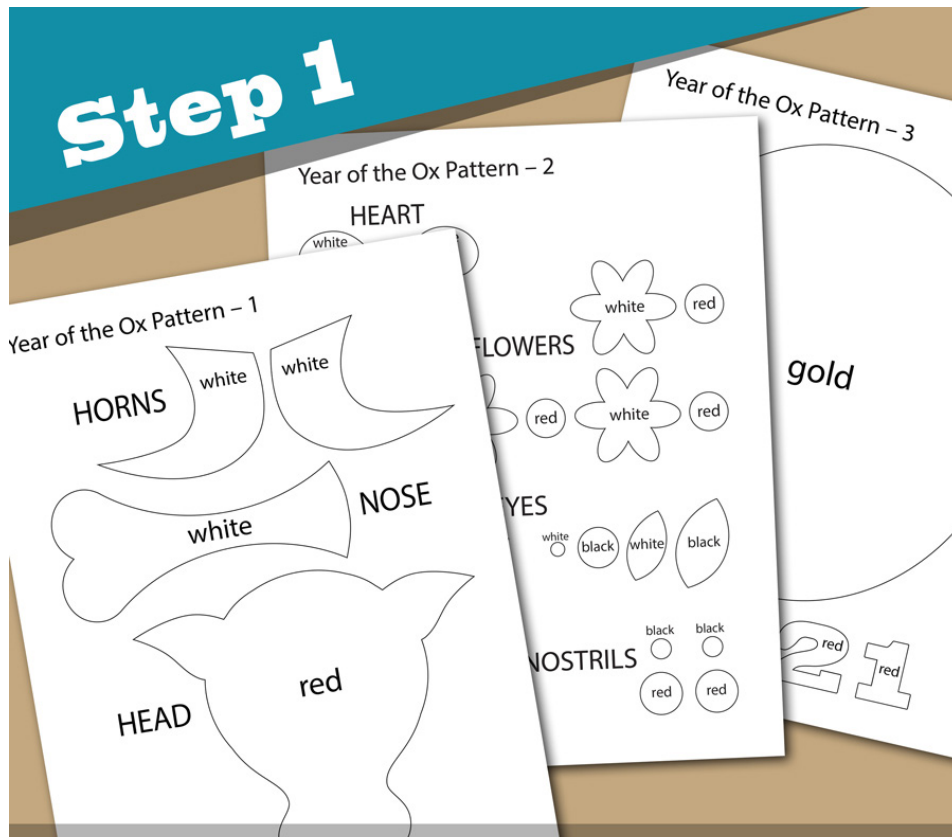


Step 1



Download pattern at <https://bit.ly/3aa5XEz>

Step 2

Use the pattern sheets to cut out the felt pieces.



Step 3



NOTE: If you choose to sew, you can change the color of thread you're using to match the piece you are sewing down. For example, use white thread to sew the white nose piece to the red face. OR, if you want a more graphic look, just use black thread for everything.

Step 4



Arrange the pieces on the gold oval as shown above. Pin down the horns, top flower, and two decorative shapes. Don't pin the face. It is only there for placement at this stage.

Step 5

Sew down red center and leave petals loose.*

Sew (or glue) the horns and decorative pieces to the gold oval piece. Be careful to keep these pieces in the same positions as you pinned them so that the face will correctly align on top.

*NOTE FOR THE FLOWER: For those who choose to sew, try sewing down the red center piece through the gold oval shape and leaving the petals loose.

Step 6



Position the face on top of the horns and sew (or glue) to the gold oval.



Sew (or glue) on the heart and two other flowers. Let the flower petals hang loose over the edge of the oval.

Step 7

The stiffer black felt sheet will be the surface of the banner.

Fold over the top edge about an inch
← Sew down the edge →

Fold over the top edge of the sheet (about an inch) to make a slot for the dowel to slide through. Sew down the bottom of the fold to secure it. This will be the back side of the banner.

Step 8

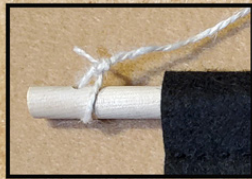


On the front side of the banner sheet, center the gold oval and sew (or glue) it to the backing, leaving room for the date at the bottom. Then sew (or glue) on the numbers.

Step 9

Add the dowel.

Slide the dowel through the slot. On each end, thread the twine through the drilled hole, then loop it around and tie a knot.



If your dowel doesn't have drilled holes, just tie the twine around the dowel with a tight knot.

And you're done!
